Alumni Updates



William G. "Guillermo" Paxton 1990 HS is now a successful author of a true crime novel, *The Plaza*. Plaza in Mexican culture is a slang word describing the territory of a certain drug cartel. Guillermo served in the Air Force during Desert Storm and after his four-year tour, he became a police officer and later worked as an undercover narcotics agent in Texas. His son, **William G. Paxton 2009 JC** also attended NMMI. He was in charge of Socorro County's first narcotics division. From 1999 to the end of 2011 he worked and lived in Juarez, Mexico, witnessing the worst of the drug wars that have infiltrated that area. Guillermo Paxton is now famous for his published work, *The Plaza*, a book based on



a true story, fictionalizing the events that he investigated or witnessed personally. His second book, *Cartel Rising* is due out in September of 2013, both are published by "No Frill's Buffalo" publishing house. A longtime Juarez resident and author, Guillermo Paxton unknowingly put his life and his family in imminent danger while doing research for, *The Plaza*. After investigating a massacre at a local bar, the federal police abducted him. Paxton and his family were threatened in no uncertain terms. After relocating to the United States, Paxton was able to seek publishing for his book with less fear of direct retribution from either the Mexican government or drug cartels.

Paxton's background is in the military and law enforcement and he has extensive knowledge and experience with the Mexican Mafia. Based on true events, many investigated by Guillermo personally, The Plaza was inspired by the murder of crime reporter Armando "El Choco" Rodriguez, of El Diario de Juarez.


