
## ARTWORK SALES HELP FUND THE TONY CAIN MEMORIAL FUND

The Tony Cain Memorial Fund was established by Tony's parents, Gilbert K. Cain 1942 JC and Alyce B. Cain, from a portion of their estate that was donated to the NMMI Foundation, Inc. As part of the gift, the Foundation also received 55 pieces of artwork that had been a part of the Cain Family Collection. This artwork is now for sale.

The sale of the artwork will be managed by the Anderson Museum of Contemporary Art located in Roswell, NM. Proceeds from the sales will be added to the Tony Cain Memorial Fund.

Earnings from the fund will be used to support scholarships and leadership programs at New Mexico Military Institute in memory of Tony Cain. Scholarships will be awarded to cadets who meet the minimum eligibility requirements set by the Scholarship Committee while giving consideration to cadets enrolled in the junior college division who demonstrate a financial need.


# Alumni Reported Deceased Since Last Publication
