Centennial Celebration

Every year NMMI and the Alumni Relations Office is thrilled to host numerous Alumni, family and friends during a homecoming celebration. It was a day of fun, adventure, and new memories. Thank you to everyone who joined us—we can't wait for the next one!







HIRAM DOW

April 21, 1885 - March 7, 1969






In 1898, Hiram Dow began his journey at the New Mexico Military Institute (NMMI) as a cadet, graduating in 1905 as a First Lieutenant in "B" Company. His lifelong commitment to NMMI and the Roswell community is evident in his service as Roswell's mayor, Lieutenant Governor of New Mexico, and member of the Board of Regents (BOR). Dow was instrumental in founding the Alumni Association and initiated the first Alumni Jubilee in 1923, fostering unity and tradition. His legacy lives on through Dow Hall, dedicated in 1957 and rededicated in 2005 following renovations.

At the remembrance ceremony, we will honor this legacy alongside three of his descendants:

- Brigadier General Mark Dow, HS 1969, JC 1971 (Great-nephew of Hiram Dow and grandson of Robert Dow, Class of 1909)
- James Dow, HS 1973, JC 1975 (Great-nephew of Hiram Dow and grandson of Robert Dow, Class of 1909)
- Mrs. Lea Fraser (Granddaughter of Hiram Dow and Greatgranddaughter of Capt. Joseph C. Lea)

Joining them will be Mrs. Fraser's daughter, the great-granddaughter of Hiram Dow and great-great-granddaughter of Capt. Joseph C. Lea.








Colts Triumph 35-0 in Season Opener!




