The 13th Annual Generals Cup was a resounding success thanks to the support of so many individuals both near and far. For the past 12 years this has been the signature fundraising event held by NMMI with the proceeds going to support cadets through incentive scholarships and providing support for cadet activities. Year 13 was no different, 240 golfers participated in the event and enjoyed a practice round, two tournament rounds plus all the food, drinks and fun they could handle.

Roughly \$159,000 was raised leading up to the event and over \$80,000 of that went back to the school to support our current and future corps of cadets. Over the course of the last 13 years this event has created an endowment over \$500,000 dollars and provided \$200,000 in direct funding through the incentive scholarship program.



















### Alumni Staff Volunteers Support Roswell Community After Recent Flooding


# Congratulations to Our Bronco Cross Country Team!
